At no point were students or staff placed at risk, and the situation has been dealt with. We understand that news of such incidents can cause concern, but please be reassured that our priority remains the safety of every child in our care.

Our strength as a community lies in working together. We ask all parents and carers to remain vigilant and share any concerns that may help us keep our school safe. Keeping children safe online is essential. Apps like **Snapchat** can expose young users to privacy risks and inappropriate content. Snapchat requires users to be **at least 13 years old**, but even then, parental guidance is crucial – please see the attached infographic for further information and support.

- **Monitor usage:** Know which apps your child uses and how they interact online.
- **Set boundaries:** Use parental controls and discuss safe online behaviour.
- **Educate:** Explain why sharing personal information or engaging with strangers can be dangerous.

Your involvement helps protect your child from cyberbullying, scams, and exposure to harmful content. Stay informed and keep communication open—online safety starts at home.
