On Monday 13th October, students in Carlo House will be permitted to take part in a non-uniform day to celebrate Carlo Feast Day.

Students are encouraged to wear red for Carlo as a sign of unity and pride in their House. We are also inviting voluntary donations of £1, which will go towards Carlo House's chosen charity. Please note that this non-uniform day is for Carlo House students only. Any student who attends school in non-uniform and is not a member of Carlo House will be required to return home to change into full school uniform.

Each of our school Houses will celebrate their own Feast Day during the year as part of our wider house system celebrations:

- **Carlo House** – 13th October (Feast of Saint Carlo Acutis)
- **Teresa House** – 11th February (Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes)
- **More House** – 22nd June (Feast of Saint Thomas More)

Non-Uniform Day Expectations:

While non-uniform days allow students the freedom to wear their own clothes, we maintain certain standards to ensure safety and decency:

- Open-toed footwear is prohibited.
- Clothing considered too revealing, such as vest tops or tops that expose the midriff, is not allowed.
- Shorts must be of a reasonable length and should not have cut-out holes that expose excessive skin.

Please adhere to our [uniform policy](#) that states what is acceptable for non-uniform days.

The school reserves the right to determine what is deemed acceptable, acknowledging that fashion trends are continuously evolving.
